Lovosice Terminal

The terminal is favourably located within the IVth Pan-European Corridor, and it is part of an industrial estate combining road, railway, and water transport. Its traffic system features a high traffic-carrying capacity for all types of transport. This multimodal commodity centre can offer a wide range of services due to the river port, railway terminal and road terminal.
